A Cantata for the Fourth Sunday of Easter, 'Good Shepherd Sunday', elaborating the familiar depiction of Christ as our shepherd. Set by Bach for soloists and chorus, oboes d'amore, strings and continuo, the music includes suggestions of shepherds' pipes. A joyous bass aria sums up the soul's joy in having such a shepherd, and the final chorale proclaims our trust in the Lord our shepherd, who leads us his sheep to green and lovely meadows.
